Thomas Langton was born in Jan 1887 in Chorley, Lancashire, England. He died on 07 Jan 1965 in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. He married Elizabeth Ann (Annie) Kay on 22 Jan 1913 in Chorley, Lancashire, England. She was born on 06 Nov 1894 in Sabden, Lancashire, England. She died on 14 Feb 1976 in Verdun, Quebec, Canada. Together they had three sons.

Henry (Harry) Joseph Langton was born on 18 Apr 1913 in Chorley, Lancashire, England. He died on 24 Oct 2008 in Sainte Anne's Veterans' Hospital. He married Elsie Goldthorpe on 13 Sep 1947 in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. She was born on 19 May 1921. She died before 2008.

John Gerald Langton was born on 29 Jan 1917 in Chorley, Lancashire, England. He died on 19 Apr 2007 in Chambly, Quebec, Canada. He married Mary Agnes Murphy on 08 Feb 1947 in Verdun, Quebec, Canada. She was born on 29 Oct 1914. She died on 17 Apr 1987.

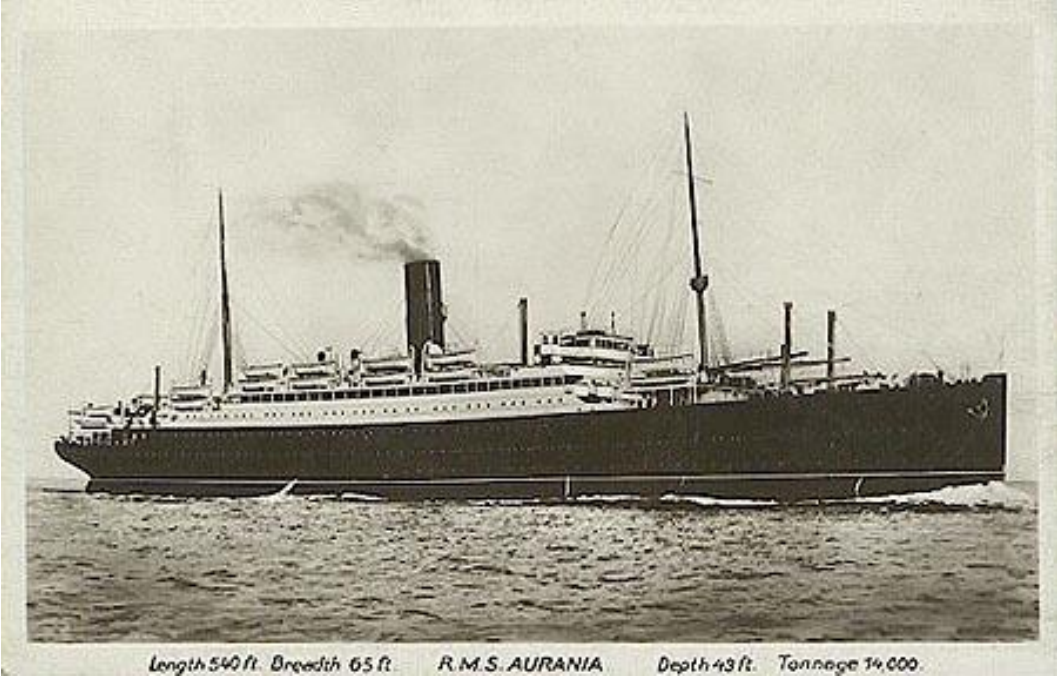

Thomas Langton and his wife Elizabeth Ann Kay Circa 1955



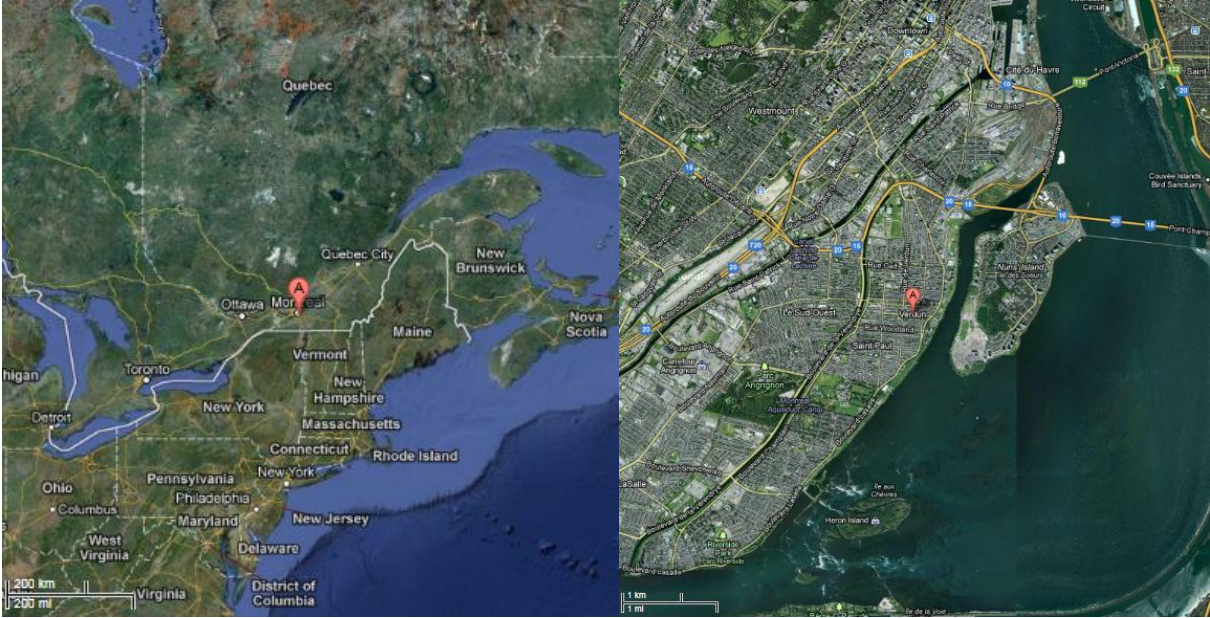
RMS Aurania Operated by Cunard Line Built by Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson, Wallsend-on-Tyne

- Thomas Langton wife Elizabeth Ann Kay

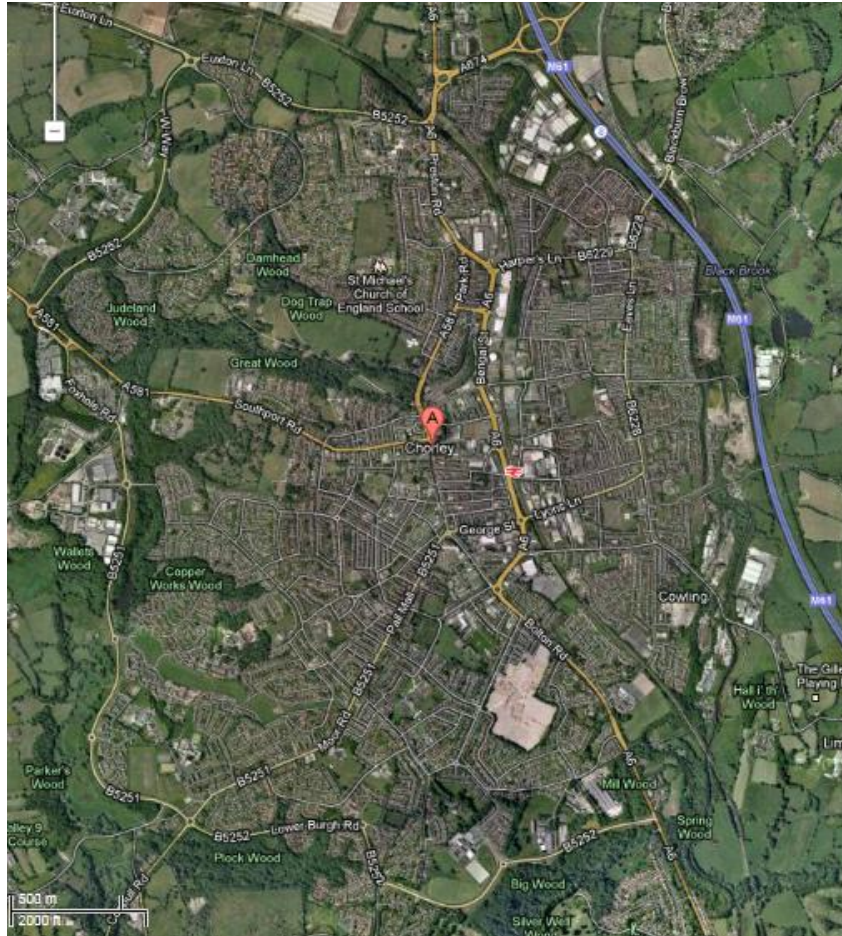
